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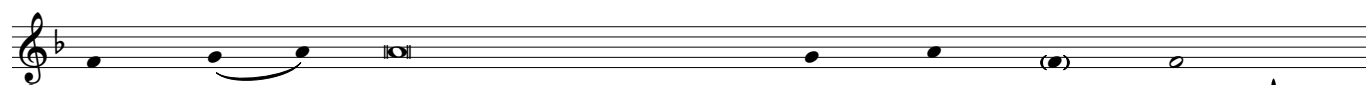

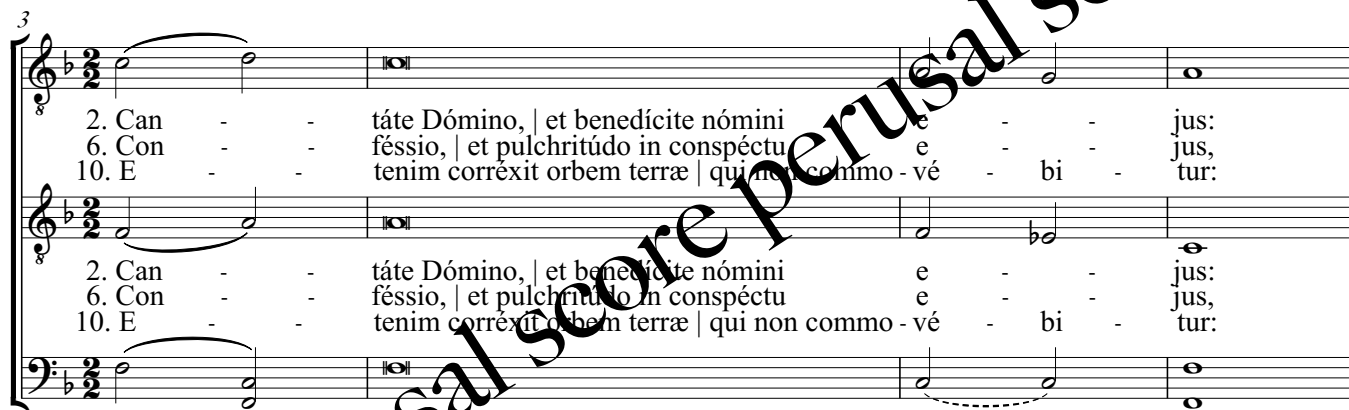

 A free rhythm with rubato should be given to all phrases as in psalmodic recitation.

TRANSLATION

Psalm 96 (95)

1. Sing a new song to the Lord; * sing to the Lord, all the earth.
2. sing to the Lord; bless his name. * Proclaim his salvation day by day.
3. Tell among the nations his glory, * and his wonders among all the peoples.
4. For the Lord is great and highly to be praised, * to be feared above all gods.
5. For the gods of the nations are naught. * It was the Lord who made the heavens.
6. In his presence are majesty and splendor, * strength and honor in his holy place.
7. Ascribe to the Lord, you families of peoples, † ascribe to the Lord glory and power; *
 ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name.
8. Bring an offering and enter his courts; * worship the Lord in holy splendor.
9. O tremble before him, all the earth. * Say to the nations, "The Lord is king."
10. The world he made firm in its place; * he will judge the peoples in fairness.
11. Let the heavens rejoice and earth be glad; † let the sea and all within it thunder praise. *
 Let the field and all it bears exult.
12. Then will all the trees of the wood shout for joy at the presence of the Lord, * for he
 comes, he comes to judge the earth.
13. He will judge the world with justice, and the peoples with faithfulness.
